The information below relates to the Jersey Triathlon 2017.

I would be grateful for your help in keeping the public up to date with the following points. If you require any further information or you would like any points clarified you can contact me on 811863. As always, I am available to come and speak on these items.

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Article 67 of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956 as amended, that in connection with the Jersey Triathlon certain roads will be closed or restricted in their use as set out below, in the parishes of St Helier, St Lawrence, St Peter and St Brelade.

ROAD CLOSURES on SUNDAY 9th JULY 2017

Between 7.15am and 13.30pm:

Victoria Avenue West Bound from West Park to Bel Royal, therefore all traffic will be diverted onto the inner road at West Park, traffic from Bel Royal going east will be diverted up Rue Du Galet or Spur Road First Tower along the inner road.

Access East bound onto Victoria Avenue will be permitted from West Park Roundabout unless access to premises. There will be access to Benests at Rue Du Galet. Traffic going westbound on the inner road will be diverted up St Peters Valley. Coaches and Buses will be permitted back on the Avenue at Rue Du Galet.

Traffic coming down La Haule Hill and Beaumont Hill will be diverted eastbound unless they are coaches or buses.

DELAYS ON ROADS

Traffic travelling along the south coast will experience delays from 7.15am until 1330pm as Victoria Avenue will be closed west bound..

PARKINGVictoria Avenue Lay-bys 1-7

The lay-bys are open for parking, but from 8.30am until 12.30pm vehicles will not be permitted to exit onto Victoria Avenue.

No Parking Areas

Top of West Park Slip Sunday

The triathlon Cycle part will take place on public highways from Rue Du Galet through all the parishes until the Cyclists return to Rue Du Galet.

CAUTION

Please ask the public to take extra care of competitors (cyclists) using the public roads in the parishes of St Peter, St Brelade, St Ouen, St Mary and St Lawrence and competitors (runners) around the St Helier course.

Also please ask the public to take care when using the Promenade around Les Jardins de la Mar and between Bel Royal and La Haule Slip as competitors (cyclists) will be travelling quickly.

LIBERTY BUS SERVICES

The bus stop at La Frigate will not be in use from 7.15 until 12noon, the nearest pick up point will be the bus stop on St Aubin's Inner Road above the lower park. All buses are running a normal service.
